## a. Review the Membership/Finance Committee Activity Timeline


We reviewed the current PCAT for Membership/Finance and all activities are right on target.

Joanne Montgomery made a motion to accept Roberta Stewart's application for Planning Council co-chair and Gloria McNeil seconded it.


